The September Principal's Challenge is to answer the question, "At what time are new clocks and watches set?" Grades 3-5 need to also tell me why they are set at that time.



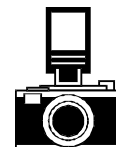
Remember to reserve your seats for the Ball & Auction. This is a fun way to support your school.
